Gabriel Jose de la Concordia Garcia Marquez is a Colombian novelist, short-story writer, screenwriter and journalist, known affectionately as Gabo throughout Latin America. He is considered one of the most significant authors of the 20th century. He was awarded the Nobel Prize in Literature in 1982, and is the one of the earliest winners of this prize. He pursued a self-directed education that resulted in his leaving law school for a career in journalism.

He wrote many acclaimed non-fiction works and short stories, but is best known for his novels, such as *One Hundred Years of Solitude*, *The Autumn of the Patriarch* and *Love in the Time of Cholera*.



His works have achieved significant critical acclaim and widespread commercial success, most notably for popularizing *a literary style labeled as magic realism*, which uses magical elements and events in otherwise ordinary and realistic situations.

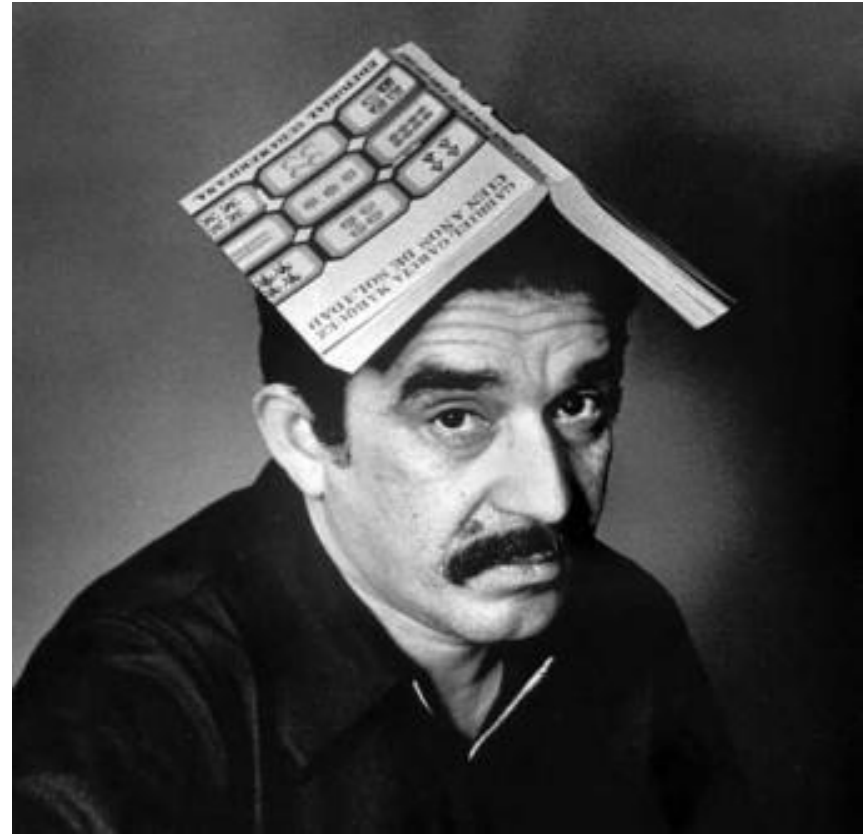

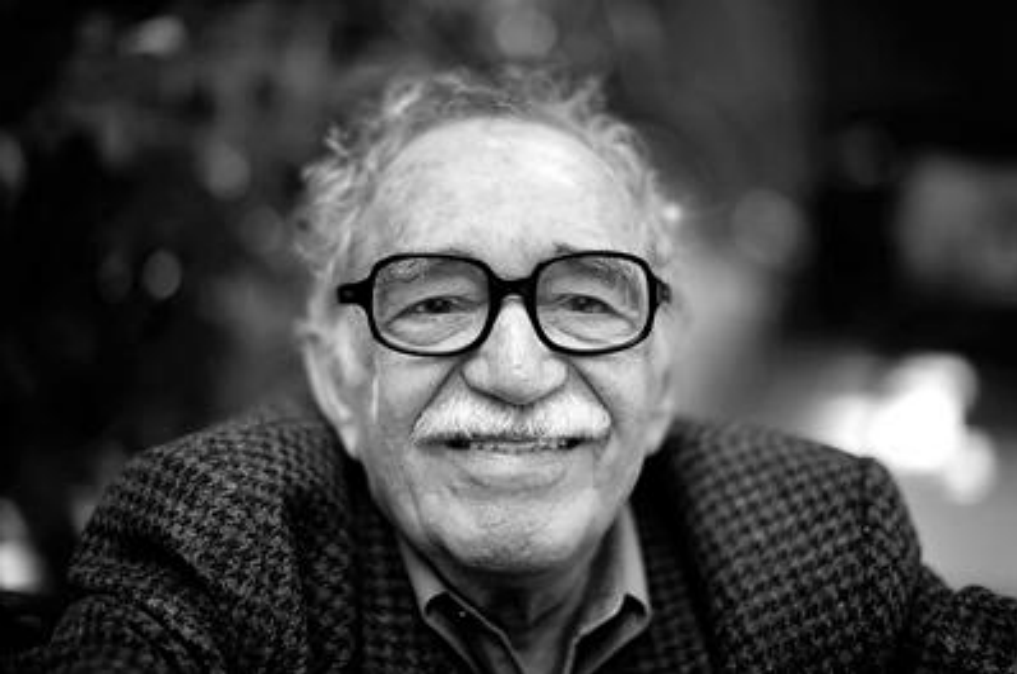
Some of his works are set in a fictional village called Macondo (the town mainly inspired by his birthplace Aracataca), and most of them explore the theme of solitude.

On his death in April 2014, Juan Manuel Santos, the President of Colombia, described him as the **"the greatest Colombian who ever lived"**.
