


Many people wanted to find a gold mine or work hard for a company to become a wealthy man, but only a few succeed.

Ten years ago, people used cellphone mainly for giving someone a ring call or send messages. No body had thought that the phone could used as a computer.








ON THE ORIGIN OF SPECIES

WATT STEAM ENGINE

The Watt steam engine, developed X sporadically from 1763 to 1775, was an improvement on the design of theNewcomen engine and was a key point in the Industrial Revolution. Watt's two most important improvements were the separate condenser and rotary motion. [2][3] The separate condenser, located external to the cylinder, condensed steam without cooling the piston and cylinder walls as did the internal spray in Newcomen's engine. Watt's engine's efficiency was more than double that of the Newcomen engine. 4 Rotary motion was more suitable for industrial power than the oscillating beam of Newcomen's engine.


